Information for Conference Vendor Stalls

The Asia Microfinance Forum 2010 is Asia's premier microfinance event, and as such demand for the limited number of vendor stalls is high.

It is expected that the Asia Microfinance Forum 2010 will be attended by up to 600 Asia's leading microfinance practitioners, policymakers, financiers, academics and advocates. To increase the knowledge sharing and networking opportunities provided by the conference, the Banking with the Poor Network will be providing vendor stalls for interested partners to showcase their relevant materials and research. Specific information is as follows:

- Stalls will be located in the breakout area just outside the main conference plenary and panel session rooms to maximise delegate traffic;
- The size of each stall will be approximately 3m x 2m;
- Stalls will be set up early morning on 13 October (first day of the conference proper) and can remain in place for the duration of the event, ending on 15 October;
- There is a charge of USD 1,500 payable (per stall) to the Foundation for Development Cooperation;
- Confirmation and payment must be made by August 30th for all stalls.
